Reptiles and Amphibians of Silverwood Wildlife Sanctuary Updated 2017

Silverwood Wildlife Sanctuary, located six miles north of Lakeside, is fully owned and maintained by the San Diego Audubon Society. The sanctuary covers 785 acres of chaparral-covered foothills, most of it rugged and trailless. There are multiple streambed corridors with live oaks. The average annual rainfall is about 17 inches, producing intermittent flowing water and vernal pools. This is list of species that have been recorded in the sanctuary but includes others (denoted by an asterisk) where range maps suggest a possible presence. Reptiles and amphibians are most commonly active in the spring and early summer, though they may be seen throughout the year. We have three species of rattlesnakes, so please be cautious and stay on trails.
